**Statement by Joseph Curto
President, New York Shipping Association on the End of the Job Action
In the Port of New York and New Jersey**

Wednesday, September 29, 2010

Although the situation that precipitated the work stoppage in the Port of New York and New Jersey has not been resolved, the ILA will return to work in the Port of New York and New Jersey today at 19:00 hours. Workers will work into the weekend to address the cargo currently in the port and the cargo anticipated to arrive henceforth.

Management and Labor representatives will meet early next week. Although poised to take further legal action in federal district court today, it was not necessary to do so.
